Our facility will continuously be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Hand sanitizer will be awaiting present at the entry door along with soap and water in our restrooms. While the risk of transmission remains low, the safety of our congregants is of utmost importance. Therefore, we are issuing the following guidelines

1. Individuals who are currently sick with fevers of 100.4 F or greater or are showing signs of a fever and any other related symptoms, been on a recent cruise, and/or been in contact with some diagnosed should seek medical assistance and stay quarantine.
2. Individuals who are currently taking fever-reducing or any other symptom-altering medicines should stay quarantine.
3. Wash your hands regularly with hot water and soap for at least 20 seconds or more to avoid spreading germs.
4. Individuals who show signs of a fever, excessive coughing and/or sneezing may be asked to voluntarily quarantine themselves to protect the safety and wellness of others.
5. To limit exposure, individuals should exercise good judgment and refrain from handshaking, hugs, and prolonged conversation in close proximity.

We will continue to monitor the impact of the coronavirus and will advise of any modifications to our plans accordingly.
